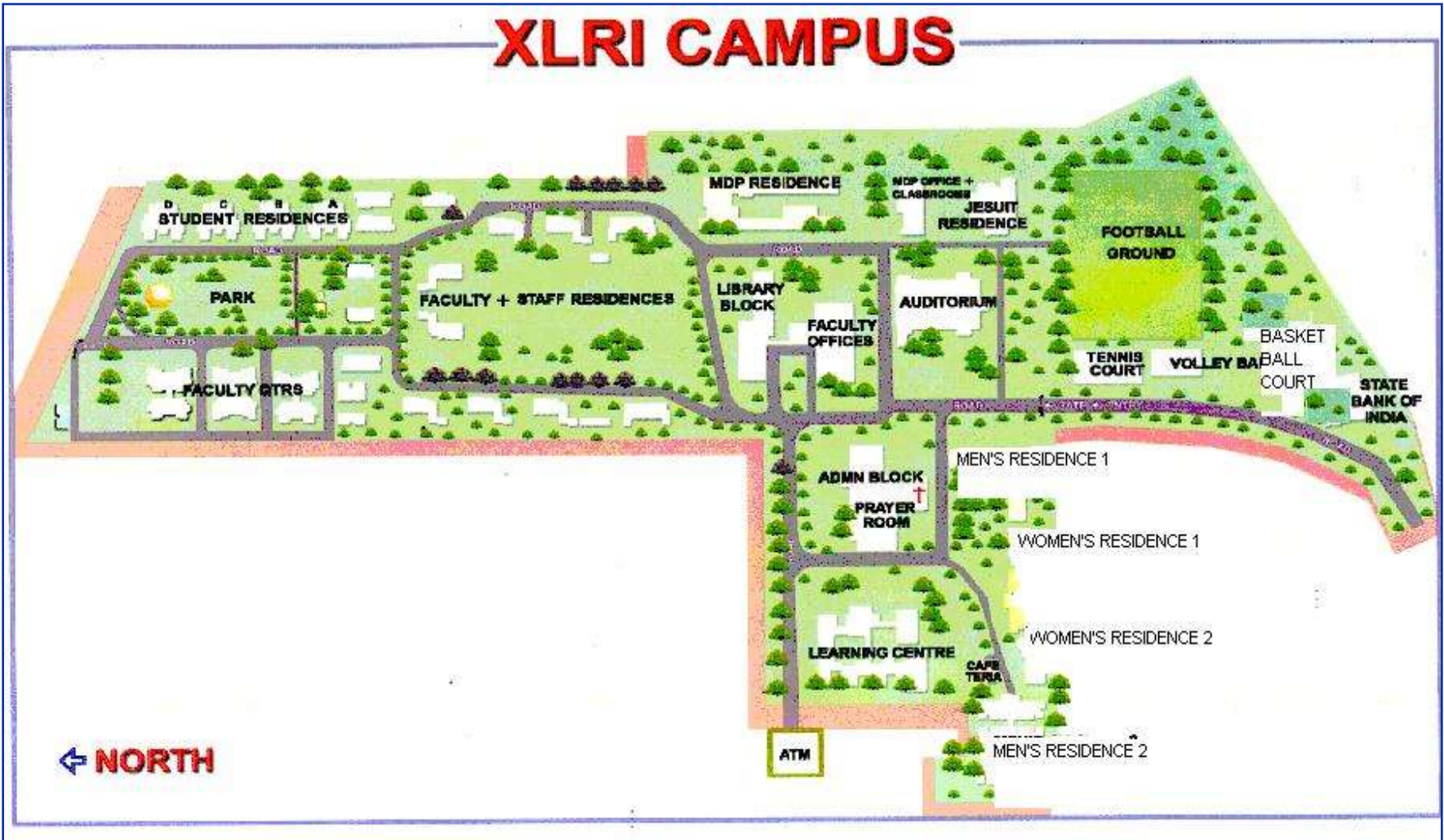
- 50 acres bordering famous zoological park and the Subarnarekha River

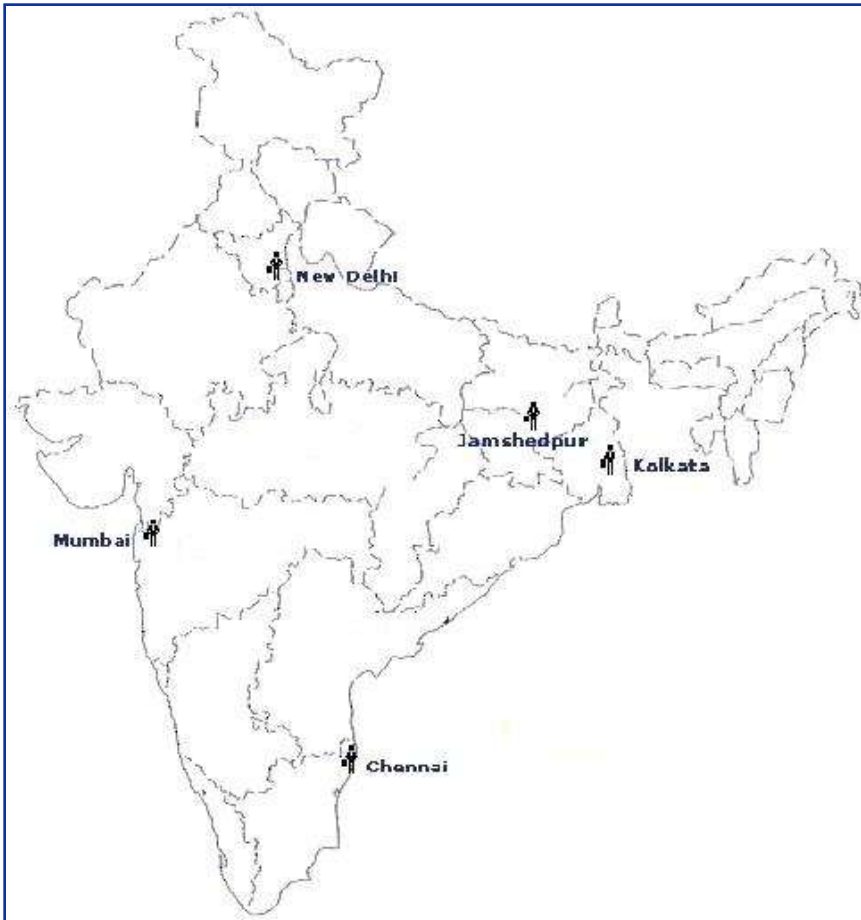

Jamshedpur to Ranchi (131 km)

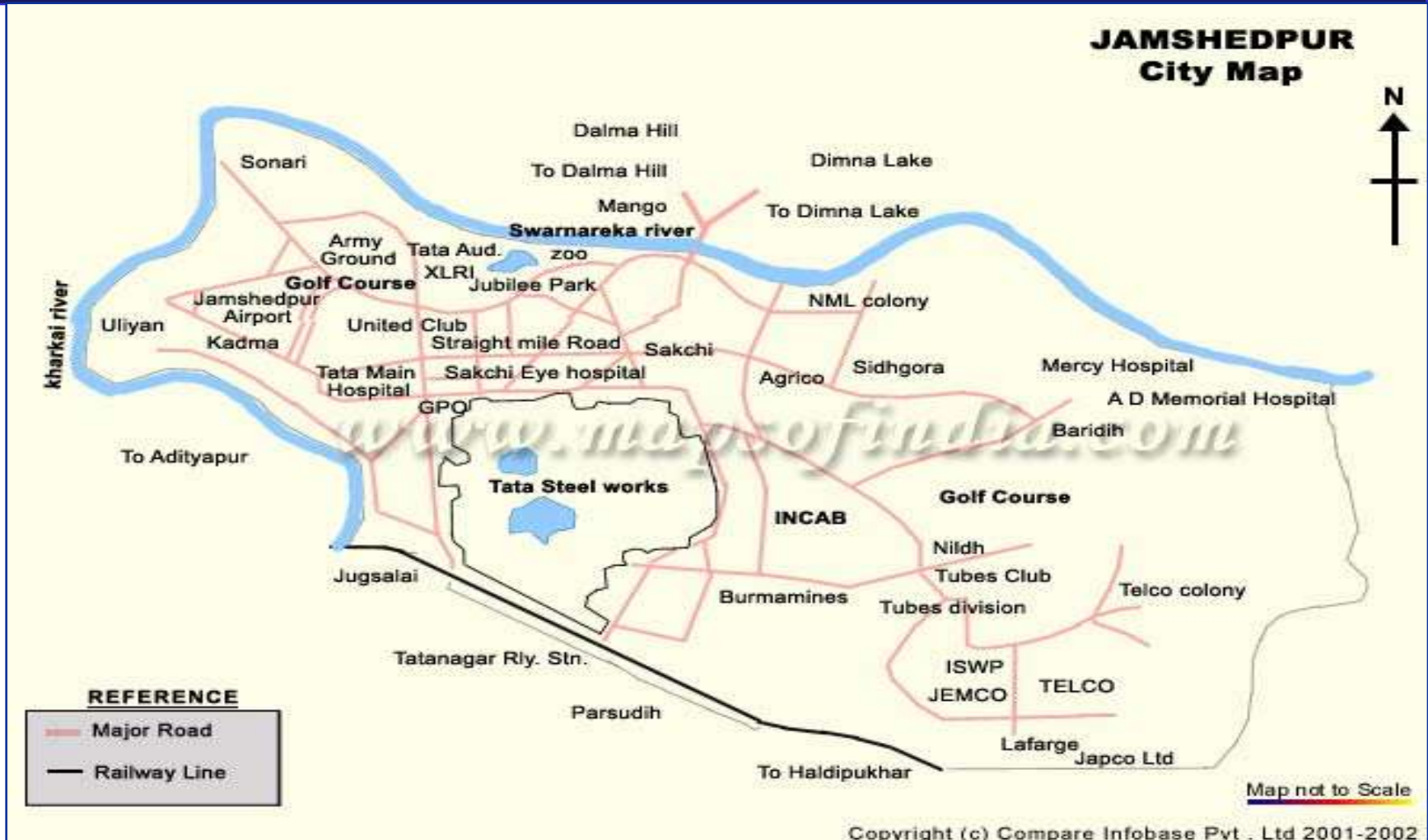
Jamshedpur to Kolkata (250 km)
